

## STATEMENT

We, Packaging Recovery Organisation Europe s.p.r.l., (PRO EUROPE), Avenue des Olympiades 2, 1140 Bruxelles / BELGIUM, represented by Managing Director Ursula Denison

declare,

1. That, based on the General Licencing Agreement with the owner of the registered trademark "Der Grüne Punkt", namely Der Grüne Punkt - Duales System Deutschland GmbH, Frankfurter Straße 720-726, 51145 Köln, Germany, PRO Europe is the general licensor for the trademark "Der Grüne Punkt" for the European Union. For the territory of the Republic of Slovenia, the trademark is duly registered with internationally applicable registration at the World Intellectual Property Organization WIPO, under No IR 653449, IR 585714, IR 585713, IR 579144, IR 653450 and IR 579145.
2. That, based on the Principal Licencing Agreement signed on 21st March 2003 with the member of PRO Europe, Slopak d.o.o., Vodovodna cesta 100, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, we conveyed to this company the sole licence for the use of the trademark The Green Dot, registered with WIPO under No IR 653449, IR 585714, IR 585713, IR 579144, IR 653450 and IR 579145 for the whole territory of Republic of Slovenia. Based on the Principal Licencing Agreement, company Slopak has the exclusive right of granting licences for the territory of Republic of Slovenia to third parties, to use the trademark "Der Grüne Punkt" on the packaging of those goods which are incorporated into the national legal rules of packaging waste and which are put on the market in the territory of the Republic of Slovenia. The permission for the use of the trademark "Der Grüne Punkt" can be issued to a third party (only obliged companies) for all packaging which comply with the definition in Paragraph 1, Article 3 of the Directive 94/62/EC of 20 December 1994.
3. That Slopak d.o.o. as contracting party proprietor of the Principal Licencing Agreement, based on new Annex No 3 to Principal Licencing Agreement signed on 16 April 2008 with PRO EUROPE, is obliged to ensure that obliged companies wanting to use "Der Grüne Punkt" on their packaging - even though they do not, for all packaging that bears the mark, use Slopak's national system under the rules implementing Council Directive 94/62/EC of 20 December 1994 on Packaging and Packaging Waste, but fulfil their compliance obligation with another system for waste packaging management in the territory of Republic of Slovenia - are able to do so based on a separate contractual agreement directly concluded between the client and Slopak.
